

Once again readers are challenged in their thinking regarding morality, Christian responsibility and their attitude toward sinners caught in the web of sin. A fun and edifying read. In 1908 the red light district in Teaville leaves a trail of broken women, children and men in its wake. Evelyn Wisely has a burden to not only care for the orphans generated by this district but also help the prostitutes escape this wretched and self-destructive lifestyle. David Kingsman, a businessman temporarily residing in Teaville, takes an interest in the children, the mission and most particularly in Miss Evelyn Wisely. But the townspeople are set against the project, and Evelyn has a secret that holds Davidâ ÂTMs attentions at bay.

This Is Melissa Jagearsâ Â™s second book in the Teaville Moral Society Series. This second book can stand alone but I think it is enriched by knowing the characters in the first book, A Heart Most Certain. The storyâ Â™s setting is the 1908 era and features woman and children caught in the red-light district. I liked the way the romance between the characters in the book held my attention but also the inspiration of someone following their dream of helping those in need. Melissa inspires me again to see the world around me that is not like my world at all, but needs to be seen with eyes of love instead of judgement. I was very touched that David Kingsman was so willing to help a woman and boy he had only just met a few times. We really get to know him during this time. David was attracted to Evelyn but she would not let him past the very high walls around her heart. Slowly a friendship develops. Her work with her parents at the orphanage and helping the children of the red-light district will have to be enough for her. With help from David, she is able to gain the support from other businessmen that Nicholas Lowe (the richest man in town and her boss) requires, for building a shelter for women who want to escape life in the district. It will take longer than Evelyn expects, years perhaps. The storytelling in this book is fantastic! Every character is well developed, even the children. Of course, we get to visit with the ladies of the Teaville Moral Society. I loved the revelation of Evelyn's long-held secret, it was not what I expected. The conclusion is a nice surprise too.
