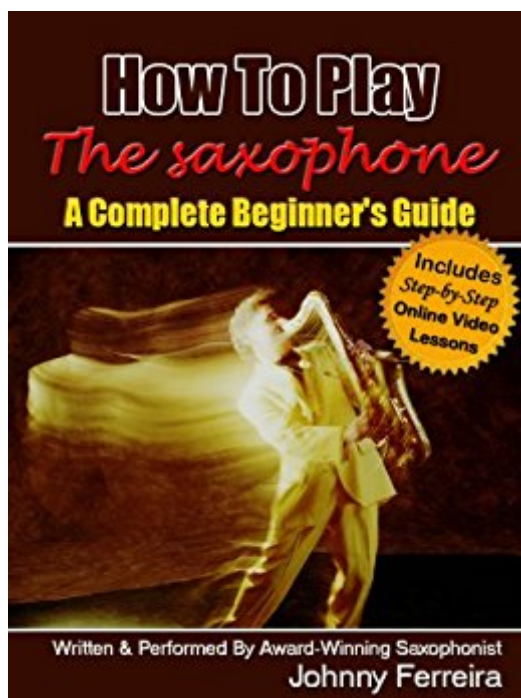

I would give it a 5 EXCEPT that the Kindle(Kindle apps version 1.11.2, dated 5-18-2015) book's index is corrupted somehow. The first few index selections work okay, but then the next three or four ask me to sign in/register. A few later selections work properly. Technical support ran out of ideas to help me and refunded my purchase. I bought it again but the same problem. DON'T BUY this product until they fix it.

I bought the kindle book at the same time that the blue's one. I hope not to be as disappointed. Videos do not correspond with the lessons links. Fingering diagrams difficult to read. Not for beginners.

This is an excellent introduction to learning the saxophone. It is simply written in an entertaining manner that doesn't alienate the beginner. I strongly recommend this book for those wanting to learn the basics of reading sheet music, as well as for the self-taught just starting to play the sax. There is a lot of very helpful information here that will greatly assist your musical development for many years to come. Begin here and go whereverNicely done, Mr. Ferreira.

I had to teach myself to read music and I had a tutor for a short time. I read books look at countless youtubes (I love youtube and they ware helpful but I could not get the basic info I need. This guide gave me what I was missing. I believe I have learned more 10 min. of the book then I have the last six months. If you are a beginner buy it soon.

This is like having your own private lessons without leaving your home. Johnny has really put time and effort into this book and has put the average learner's interest ahead of monetary gains. The

lessons are from simple to complex, but with a flair for simplicity. Well done Sir. For any one (just like me) who has been contemplating picking up that sax which has been laying around collecting dust, this is your time.

A very good book with guides to refer to. I like the click on links that show you how to play licks and it shows you fingering videos and other charts to refer to.
