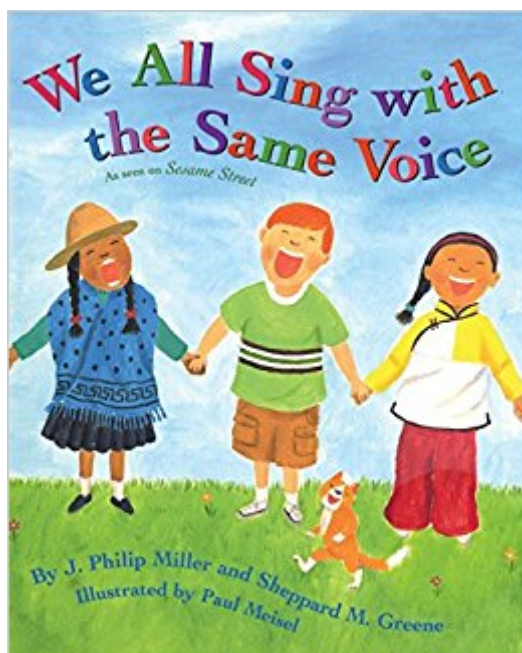

No matter where they live, what they look like, who is in their families, or what they do, all children, at heart, are the same. This Sesame Street song by J. Philip Miller and Sheppard M. Greene comes to life with Paul Meisel's happy illustrations. Children from Texas, Peru, and southern France; with black hair, red hair, or yellow hair; named Jack or Amanda Sue or Kareem Abdu; rejoice in the fact that they all "sing with the same voice."

The familiar words to this joyful song combine with vibrant illustrations to celebrate the idea that no matter where children live, what they look like, or what they do, they're all the same where it counts -- at heart.

I absolutely love this book, as does my 3 year old! I remember this song from Sesame Street when I was young so I was very excited to find this book and buy it for my daughter. The message of inclusion is timeless and the illustrations are wonderful. And if you go to YouTube you can find the video that used to play on Sesame Street. I bought a copy for my daughter's class as well and it is now my go-to book for gifts. I cannot recommend it highly enough!

Year after year, this is one of the favorite songs/books in my preschool classroom! The chorus is easy to sing along with, and the verses are catchy - the children love hearing it so much that they catch on quickly! The only slight criticism is that the song goes pretty quickly through the verses, so be prepared to turn the pages as you listen along, and be sure to look at the book with the music playing so you can spend more time on the pictures. I had to purchase a second copy (no CD, paperback) so 2-4 children could read along with the a teacher.

It took a few months to receive it but well worth the wait. Beautiful and colorful illustrations with song lyrics that I easily found on YouTube. Grandkids sing along on chorus. It's a very good song book about diversity.

This is cute enough, but my granddaughters don't care for it so much. Unless you are a Sesame Street watcher and know how to sing it, it's kind of a nothing book to read aloud to a 5 year old. It never gets picked off the shelf when they choose a book. There are other "moral" books with the same theme that are just a lot better read-aloud stories than this one.
