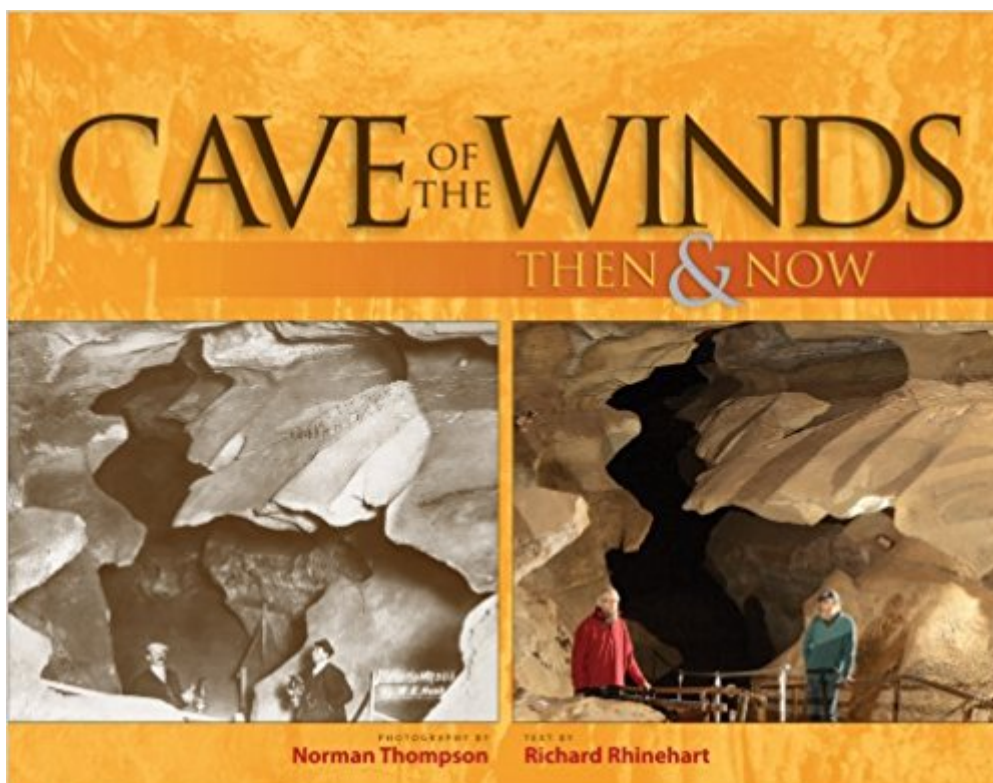

Publishers, 2011), Eighth Wonder: The Story of Glenwood Caverns and the Historic Fairy Caves (The Donning Company Publishers, 2012). From 1984 through 2013, he served as the founding editor of Colorado's Rocky Mountain Caving journal. Rhinehart is a past director and chair of the Williams Canyon Project of the National Speleological Society and the founder of the Fairy Cave Project. A graduate of the University of Colorado School of Journalism and working in communications, he makes his home in Denver. Norman R. Thompson has been caving since 1970 and has done cave photography since 1974. He is coeditor and coauthor of On Caves and Cameras: A Comprehensive Guide to Underground Photography (National Speleological Society, 2005). His photography is featured in Eighth Wonder: The Story of Glenwood Caverns and the Historic Fairy Caves (The Donning Company Publishers, 2012). Thompson's photographs have appeared in numerous books, magazines, newspapers, calendars, postcards, and note cards. His cave photography has been displayed in a number of exhibits, including one at the Smithsonian's National Museum of Natural History in Washington, D.C. He lives in Louisville, Colorado.
