

This is a great translation of the Bhagavad Gita. The introduction by Huxley, on the "perennial philosophy" is worth the price of the entire book. If you've read versions of the Gita but not this one, give it a try. I've compared it with all the major versions/translations and, from my perspective, this one is the best. I am a retired PhD in philosophy and religion and have the credentials and the experience to assess different versions/translations and also the knowledge to appreciate the grand essay by Huxley.

Here the metaphor of God speaks. Much of this could ring true, but for me some is excessive. Too much bragging for me, and does God really need mankind's love as much as indicated in these writings?

I've read several translations of the Gita simultaneously, to try and facilitate my understanding. This was easily my favorite. One never loses the sense of song, which is a masterful accomplishment in itself.

Excellent book for students of comparative religion/mythology. I'm taking a class for Lifetime Learning since I am retired now and this is the textbook we are using.
