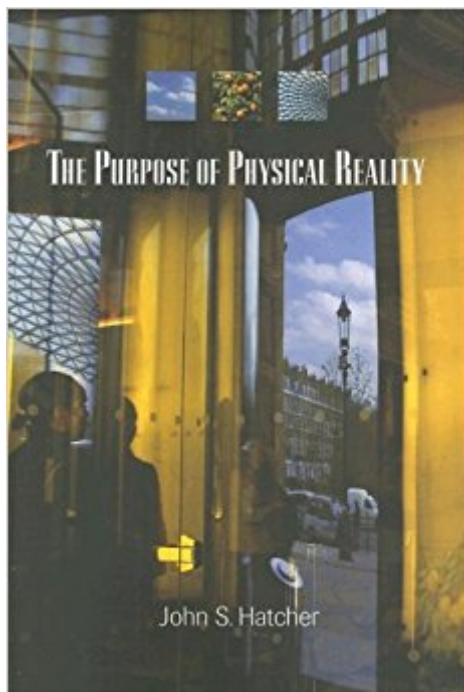

A widely published poet and distinguished lecturer, he is the author of numerous books on literature, philosophy, and Baha'i theology and scripture, including *From the Auroral Darkness: The Life and Poetry of Robert E. Hayden*; *A Sense of History: The Poetry of John Hatcher*; *The Ocean of His Words: A Reader's Guide to the Art of Baha'u'llah*; and *Close Connections*.

I really didn't plan on reading it but as I brought it home, I realized I'd never pondered what was the purpose of physical reality, especially from a spiritual perspective. Now, it's not the easiest of reading, especially the section where he compares the B'hai perspective with such other notable perspectives as Plato, Job, and Milton. But hidden within these pages are some very interesting insights. I came away with a new appreciation and a deeper understanding of the B'hai faith. I would go so far as to say that B'hai

may be the cutting edge spiritual perspective of this age. It's inclusive, comprehensive and thought evoking. As is this book. It certainly gave me a deeper appreciation for the physical reality that we all are experiencing. I found it well worth the time to read and ponder.
