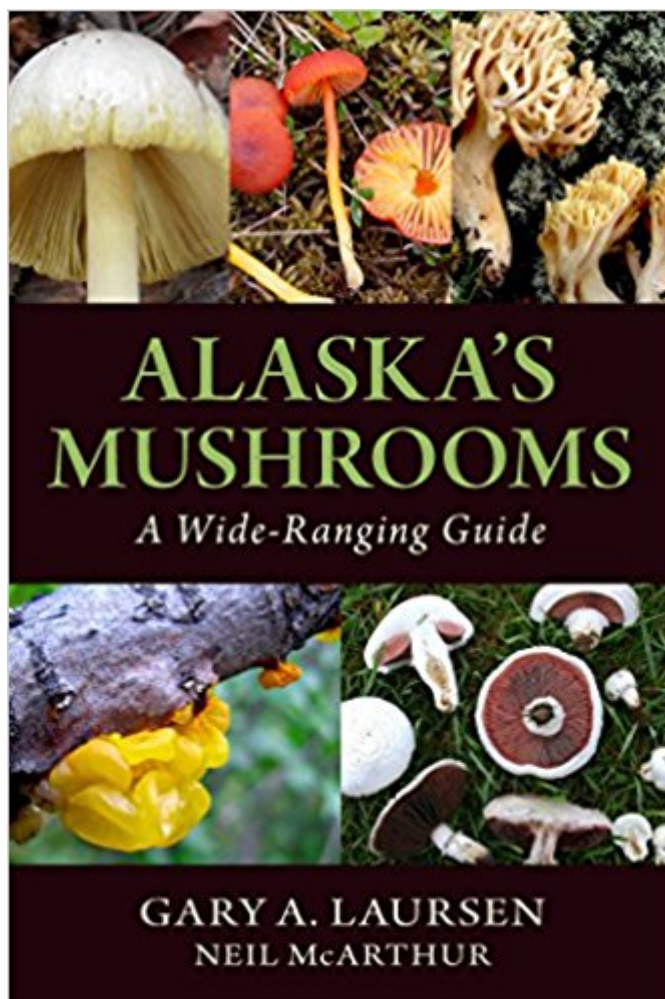

Dr. Gary A. Laursen is an adjunct Research Professor at the University of Alaska Fairbanks in the College of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, was instrumental in maintaining the state's largest and longest-running outreach program for secondary STEM research, now directs the UAF Honors Program, and faculty advises Golden Key. Neil McArthur grew up in Scotland, Quebec, and western New York, earned a B.Sc. in forestry from Syracuse in 1962, and ran away to Alaska. He worked as naturalist, forester, game biologist, cartographer, greenhouseman, carpenter, and museum facility manager. Neil helped his wife, Harriette Parker, author the 1994 Alaskaâ€™s Mushrooms, and provided most of its photos.

The book is great. As an Alaskan mushroom hunter it's a very helpful addition to the many field guides I already own. I especially appreciate that it's specific to the region and by an expert Alaskan mycologist. My issue is purely a technological one. I purchased the digital Kindle version and it is riddled with strange typographical errors. There are words that are obviously missing letters, mostly at the beginning of paragraphs (such as the word "This" appearing as "is."). Many words with double consonants are screwed up, like the word "flattened" appearing as "flaened." Several places have words that are literally on top of one another. Through the entire book.
