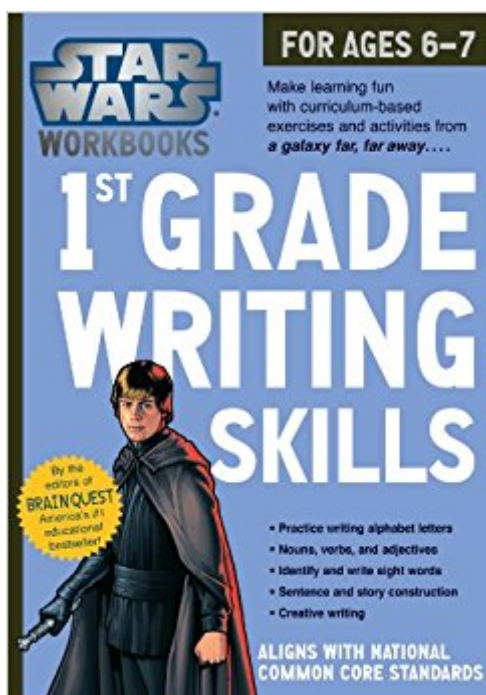

And Language Arts: Circle the correct homophone in this sentence: Luke is a Jedi knight/night. Featuring favorite characters like Luke Skywalker, Queen Amidala, Yoda, and Obi-Wan Kenobi, and other creatures, monsters, Jedi, and Sith, the workbooks are filled with thousands of original illustrations drawing from all six Star Wars movies and the expanded Star Wars universe. Purchased this book for a 6 year old cousin of mine who finds Star Wars interesting now. She really enjoys using this book. There are many games and reading exercises that expand her reading and comprehension skills. She is an above average learner and this book holds her interest. I will definitely look into purchasing more books from this company.

Full color pages with simple reading. My son is 1st going into 2nd but is a bit behind in reading. We got this so that he can practice and not have the summer slide. I like that there is a little bit of writing practice, too. Most pages so far ask offer a particular type of word like short a or long e. So, the child gets practice on one type of word. This is good for my learning reader. The Star Wars theme keeps it more engaging for him. He doesn't complain (as much) because it's a fun topic.

While I like the way this workbook is structured, I feel much of it is a little advanced for first grade(the punctuation of character names and places). Other than that I like it, but it will be sitting on a shelf for a while until my young reader has more practice.

This set of books (reading, writing, and math) have been great for my son but he was only starting Kindergarten when we started it and it was just the right level. So, I would think it would be too easy for the average 1st grader. My son loves Star Wars and these books have been very motivating for him. They are fairly similar to the types of worksheets that he is doing at school. Great extra practice for breaks and weekends!

I have this as practice for my son between 1st and 2nd grade. He loves to use it and often starts

working on it independently. It has letter practice, as well as creating sentences and other basic grammar and writing skills. It's not just a handwriting book, if that is what you might be wondering. I wasn't sure. It does both, of course, but it also teaches grammar.

My son is a huge Star Wars fan so I bought this during the summer before 1st grad to keep up his writing skills and he was so excited to work on it every day! He wrote lots of words and sentences related to Star Wars!

My son loved these work books. He has a hard time keeping focused on homework but not with these. He did them mostly by himself and hardly asked for help, which is unusual for him. Kept him engaged and built his confidence. Very Impressed. Would highly recommend to parents.

My son is going to the first grade, so I got this book (and others) for him to work on over the summer. They are not as advanced as I thought they would be but my son loves them and it keeps his mind active during the summer break. I will be ordering the 2nd grade ones soon.
