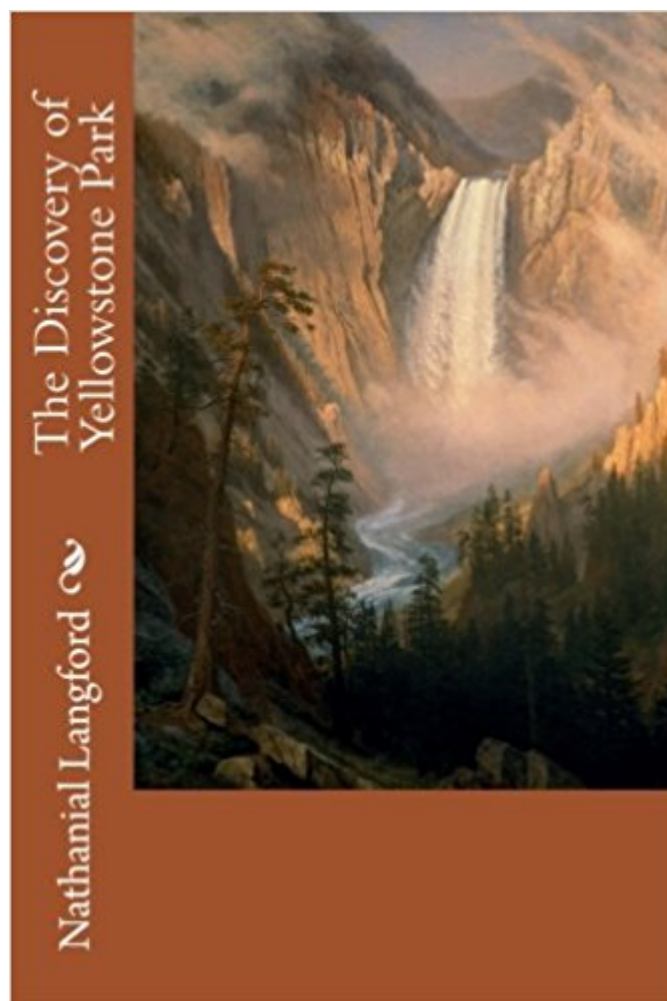

As one would expect of such an undertaking, the account contains some inaccuracies, including taking credit for the development of the national park idea. None the less, the account is narrated with great enthusiasm and prose by an experienced, albeit self-absorbed author. Highly recommended for the student of Yellowstone.

This book is well written and contains many facts that are often omitted from books written in the last few years. Even if you think you know ALL about Yellowstone, there are things written in this book that will bring you up short and make you realize that, perhaps, there IS more to learn about America's first National Park. A good book to have in your library.
