I read a review of *The Bright Effect* by a friend and was intrigued. Well, the book arrived in the evening on Friday and I finished reading at about 11:30 that same night. Yes, finished in one evening! The story of Amelia Bright and Sebastian "Bash" Holbrook is as heartwarming as it is heartbreaking -- and that's not a spoiler by the way -- with twists and turns that are never predictable. The writing duo has crafted rich and engaging primary and secondary characters who quickly become as real as any of the people in your life. The writing is well done and pulls you into the story of Amelia and Bash and keeps you turning the pages because you must know how their story unfolds. I strongly recommend *The Bright Effect* to all fans of Young Adult literature and to all fans of excellent storytelling.

It's 1.30am and I've just finished this book. I don't know what to write. How do you get across to people the weight of emotion that I got from this book? It's hard to explain...it made me cry, laugh, and at one point I thought my heart was literally going to leap out of my chest. Daughton and Cope did an amazing job on this novel! The writing is lyrical and engaging and heartbreaking and uplifting and utterly seamless. I didn't really know what *The Bright Effect* was going to be about going into it, I simply one-clicked it because I love Autumn Doughton's writing. I'm so glad I went into this book "blind." I think had I known what was to come I would have read it differently. I read it full speed ahead and fell in love with the cast of characters. The other reviews have covered all the basics. In a small voice I confess, I'm scared. I don't want to always look at things from a distance so that I can hold on to this idea that they're so perfect and flawless. I want to be close enough to see the cracks and all of the dark spaces. And if it's true that all of my tomorrows are really beginning right this minute, I know exactly how I want them to go." "You break it, you buy it." "So follow me."

*The Bright Effect* is a YA Romance that brings you two young hearts from two different worlds. Sebastian is a young man at 18 left raising his 7 year old brother after the passing of his mother. Amelia is a twin but also school and getting into college is his #1 priority. Friendship sparks and love ignites until one fateful day changes it all. Amelia has to deal with her own tragedy & in the meantime, pushes Bash away. In the meantime, Bash not only is losing his girlfriend but maybe losing a battle his own. I love this book and the other books of both of these authors has written. This was a beautiful tragic story that will stay with me for a long time.

Autumn Doughton and Erica Cope do it again! I'm not sure how they write such good YA but it's refreshing during these days when NA has taken a bit of a dive. And, for the first time in a long time, I can easily say that I loved Sebastian even more than Amelia -- he was so good! I have found male MCs in dual POV YA and NA contemporary novels lacking this past year but not so in this book!
