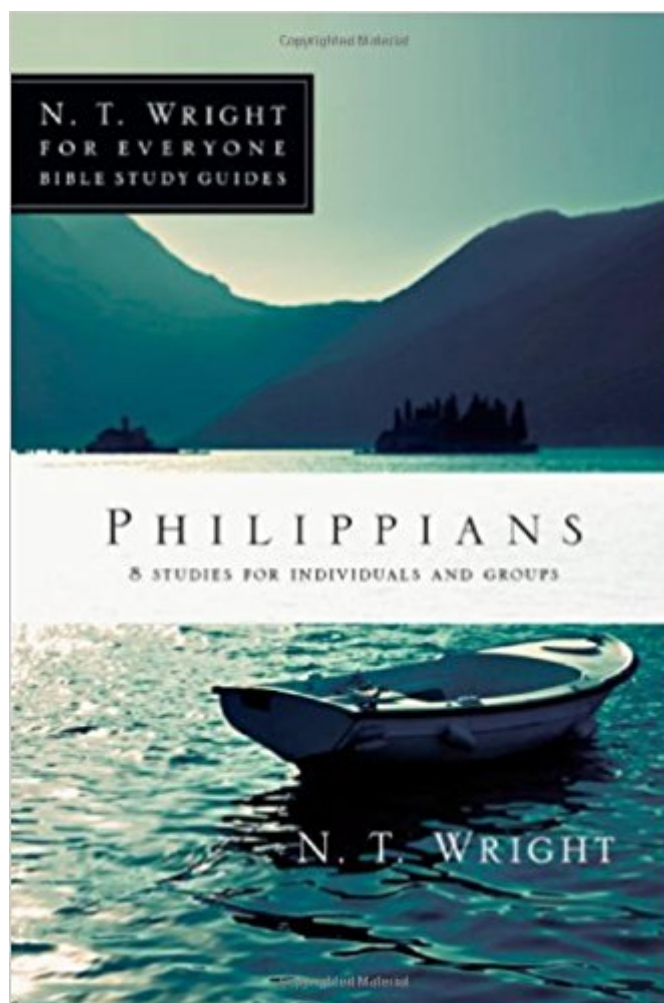

When our Sunday School class first started to use this book, i found the questions to be boring and

unhelpful. They weren't giving me any new insights at all, and our class discussion was not happening. Further into the book, I have found some helpful insights. To be honest, I was hoping for a lot more commentary, rather than mainly a list of questions for each Biblical section. But I am grateful for some questions which did give me a new vision of what the theology of Paul was about. Considering how much NT Wright has studied the works of Paul, it could be meatier.
