


The book was found

Won't Back Down: Teams, Dreams, And Family



Synopsis

Whether on a baseball field as the only girl on an all-boys team in Hammond, Louisiana, or on a basketball court where her play-making ability was compared to Louisiana legend Pistol Pete Maravich, Kim Mulkey was a young athlete so gifted she was named to Parade magazine's 1980 All-America High School Girls Basketball team. Mulkey went on to win two national championships at Louisiana Tech, as well as a gold medal with the 1984 U.S. Women's Olympic basketball team. She served as an assistant coach on Louisiana Tech's 1988 national championship, then turned around Baylor University's women's basketball program by coaching them to a national championship in a mere five years. In *Won't Back Down*, Mulkey reveals the many trials she has overcome, and how her children and her coaching have sustained her in her most difficult moments.

I love her as a coach and cheer for her team but as a writer maybe not so much. The book got a little tedious with the I, I, I, and I. Of course it was a memoir so what can you expect, but maybe there would be another way to reword some of the cheering for yourself. So much for the book she is still one of my favorite coaches.

A nice look back through the years with Coach Kim but I don't rank it as high as other books of this type. It does not reach some of the heights of others and some of the personal stuff gets short coverage but that is her right. The situation with LATECH was described well but was sad on a few levels. Its hard to think of this women begging as she describes. The book is a good quick read but could have been more. Its clear that Coach Kim has sacrificed for her career, players and program.
