

Alan Watts is one of the most profound thinkers of the 20th century, in my opinion. I've read many of his books over the years & with the advent of the Internet & specifically YouTube listened to the many recorded lectures & talks he gave over the years. This is one of his best books I think. He makes esoteric topics like mysticism & eastern religions somewhat understandable for the western mind & this book is no exception. Highly recommended.

This is one of my most favorite books of all time. It is a treatise on how the genders can approach each other on some middle ground of sorts, by saying that couples can discover "what it can mean just to touch hands or the intimacy of a kiss...without having to make something of it." Brilliant!

I read Nature "Man and Woman" in paper back, when just out of high school. It introduced me to Eastern philosophy and to Alan Watts. I thought it was time to add the hard cover edition to my library. Where else but partners would one look?

One does not complete this book. This book serves as a constant reference to not only spiritually, but just generally for life's ills and triumphs. Watts exemplifies his ability to engage the reader so directly in easy to understand language and conceptually simple examples, while still being broad enough to suggest his wisdom for the majority of one's spiritual, emotional and cognitive queries.

Watts' work is still amazingly relevant. His exposition of timeless philosophical themes is deep and accessible at the same time. His articulation of the limits of narrow logical consciousness is still the

best antidote to the sickness of the current hyper-capitalist disrespect for nature that I have read. He flows easily from discussion of narrow consciousness to a discussion of more natural and intuitive forms of consciousness to the application of that intuition in interpersonal relations. Still amazing!

I absolutely love Alan Watts and his writing is phenomenal. He describes this book specifically as his favorite piece in terms of written and philosophical structure.

I bought this as a gift and he loved it!

I decided to transition into a better person decades ago. That everything that I know and believe was founded on my social experiences to date.
