

Rodanas's colored-pencil and watercolor illustrations depict a young boy in a tattered robe carrying a doumbek, representative of drums in the Middle East. The single line of text per page coupled with the richly hued double-page

illustrations make this story ideal for sharing. The musical score and lyrics to all three verses appear on the last page.
