

Anyone who has raccoons in their lives (or garbage cans) will gain a greater appreciation (and possible love) for these critters through Dorcas MacClintock's right-to-the-heart writing. I loved the drawings, some made me laugh as raccoon antics were masterfully illustrated. This book is a treasure...
