

In

addition, there are over 50 new color images of key works in the history of Greek art, including the Hera of Samos, the Motya charioteer, the Parthenon frieze, and newly commissioned photography of one of the masterpieces of later Greek art, the Alexander Sarcophagus.

Å Å Å Å Å Å Å Written in a clear style, the book neatly balances lucid description with insightful interpretation and discussion. Intended for students and art enthusiasts of any age, it provides the most accessible and authoritative introduction to Greek art and archaeology available today.

Pedley writes very ambiguously and leaves out a lot of major details. It is also very difficult to follow his writing because he jumps for topic to topic so quickly. I would only recommend this book in the context of a college course because otherwise you lose a great deal of information.
