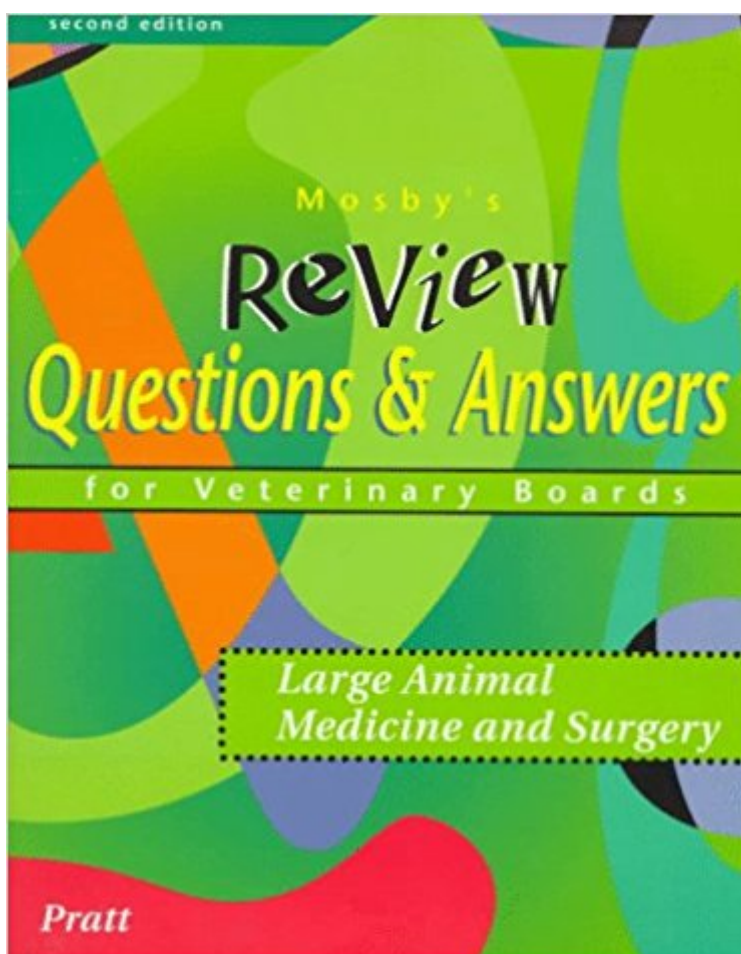

Rationales are included with correct answers so readers will be able to determine why an answer was correct and which areas require further study. Questions reflect those likely to appear on the NBE.

I passed boards without ever really using this book- I bought most of the Mosby's series as they were highly recommended by other students/recent grads and professors. Many of the questions/answers were out of date. The review questions are not similar to the format of boards questions, so it doesn't help you that way either. If you are just looking for a supplemental book of quick questions to test yourself on and you have the time for some extra study material, than these books will be alright for you. If not, there are far more valuable resources out there for you to spend

your time and money on. Likes: Quick questions Can do short study sessions between class/clinics Dislikes: Some questions have out of date information Not in board question format Some questions not relevant (would unlikely be on boards) Bottom line: There are better study resources out there. Use this only if you have time for a supplemental study aid.

I just use it as a fun way to review like playing a trivia game (albeit one I usually can't convince non-vet students to play with me) :) I have heard the questions are harder than the ones on the real test
