

For those wondering which version NLT this is considering they have revised a few times in the past decade, this is the 2015 revision. If you download the sample, you'll notice the inside cover states it's copyright 2013, but the Publisher's Note references 2015. I had to actually purchase to verify it's the newest and one can tell by comparing a verse such as Proverbs 2:20 (differences noted on NLT's website "2015 NLT Update List"):2013:Follow the steps of good men instead, and stay on the paths of the righteous.2015:So follow the steps of the good, and stay on the paths of the righteous.Also owning the Catholic and compact KJV versions, I'm a fan of The One Year Bible format of including OT/NT/Prov/Ps (plus Deuterocanonical in the Catholic version) per day since it gives a good change of gears that you can keep track of for casual reading instead of having to use multiple bookmarks. I'm hoping they come out with a compact NKJV soon, or an updated NLT compact.

How can anyone complain about a Bible? I bought this MP3 version of the NLT Bible. I have the paperback version published by Tyndale. The cover pictured is also the same cover being used by Tyndale now for its NLT one year Bible so of course, I thought the wording in my Bible would be exactly the same as the words Todd Busteed would be reading. But I was wrong. I have read this version a couple of times and the NIV a couple of times and the Good News once and I like the NLT the best. In the past, I found by listening to a narrator read the names as you read the names, it significantly enhances your ability to pronounce them. Maybe I have ADD because as he is reading if the words are not in the same order, my mind quickly bounces around to figure out where we are. In the beginning of the first MP3 disc, Mr. Busteed says he is reading the NLT second addition. I am going to buy another copy of the Tyndale Bible with the same cover as this box and hope the wording is the same. If it isn't I will give the MP3's away. Let's face it, when you are listening to anything, often you are not paying the same attention to someone else's reading as you would your own. The voice on the first day is very nice and he is simply reading. I have had other versions where the readers dramatize the reading as though they are actors. I don't like this. One audio version I owned once had a woman read the parts where a Bible woman was speaking. I didn't like that either. I actually don't want the readers interpretation when they are reading. I only loaded the first two discs onto my computer. I don't know if Mr. Busteed is the only narrator but I like his reading so I hope he is the only reader.

This book was in spanking new condition. It is just the right size for my backpack. If you are not familiar with One Year Bibles illustrated, they present the entire Bible in a year's worth of readings.

Each day includes the OT, NT, Psalms and Proverbs. I also enjoy giving them at Christmas.

I found this version completely understandable. I appreciated the opportunity to "engage". The encouragement to dig deeper and gain a more thorough understanding of the word was a wonderful blessing! Thank you.

I appreciate that the scripture reading for the day is conveniently grouped together instead of having to jump around looking for the next text. I really like the colourful illustrations. The companion book "Praying Through The Bible" by Sheri Fuller adds so much to the banquet of His Word. I recommend this Version of the Bible for personal DAILY reading.

This form of a Bible in one year is really nice. It has a section on the Old Testament, New Testament, Psalms, and Proverbs every day in a format that is not time consuming, well organized, and is "do-able" for busy people. The main thought for the day is in bold print. The daily readings are just right for having time to think about what you are reading and have something to "chew on" all day. I prefer the modern translations, and the NLT is modern English that preserves the reverence and poetry of the older versions.

I had the Chronological version of this bible previously and really liked it. I got this version for a change of pace, and it is very nice. The variety in each day makes it alot easier for take something away from each session.

pages are a little t hin but that's for pretty much all of these. I love the bits of color and the white-white pages are easier on the eyes for me. I wish the chapters were bolder- they're tiny but at least they don't distract from the reading. I find the color helps my focus better
