

I have used Lifeguide Bible Studies in the past. This one for Hebrews is not as in-dept as other books of the Bible. I have completed five chapters to date and even my friend who is doing this study with me says it doesn't require much thought to answer the questions.

An overview that is solid, but for those wanting to dig into the meat of Hebrews I would want a more intensive study.
