

We are covering 2 chapters per Sunday and that is a pretty good pace but it could be lengthened to cover just one chapter per week. It is a short booklet and the bible readings are given but not included. A short paragraph or two sets up each

session. At the end of the booklet is a leaders guide. It's pretty brief but does give some good suggestions about how to answer the questions. So, it's a short booklet with good questions but not much reading material. The leader guide is in each booklet and is not too detailed but a good starting place.
