A bi-lingual Hebrew/English publication, the Hebrew text fully vowelized. The lucid translation is fully annotated with source references and commentary. Also planned as a companion to True Existence is a Video-CD featuring Rabbi Manis Friedman, an expositor of Chasidic thought, as he discusses several themes of the discourse and offers insights into the topics discussed in the book in a clear, understandable style.
