This book contains a stiff cardboard jacket with a plastic slot for each of the fifty quarters inside the front and back cover. The center consists of a booklet that gives information on each of the fifty states. What I really liked most about this is that is the size! The book is aprox $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ which makes it real easy to handle and store. I bought one of these for each of my children to have. It is much better than the huge cumbersome map they sell on TV!

I originally wrote an extremely positive review for this product...I ordered 16 of this product- following my review...and the product had changed from the original one I had purchased. The original folder I purchased was published in 1999 and it was awesome- the 16 I purchased afterwards were published in 2005 and they are junk! The original had a fingernail slot with the quarter hole - making them easy to remove and replace- the newer one has just a round slot for the quarter- and some of them fall out- I gave 4 of them to my older grandchildren- along with the quarters- for them to do- not realizing that the design had changed - it was an utter fiasco-I had been so excited to give these to them- telling them "how cool" they were- and then they had such trouble getting them in the holes and then the quarters kept falling out. What a disappointment and what a rip- I am stuck with 12 inferior folders- besides the ones I gave away already! I can't believe this product is still on the
market- Scholastic should pull it - and do a review- I can't believe they even let this item pass! It was made in China! GO FIGURE! The original was published in Canada! If I had a choice I would give this product a zero or negative. Don't waste your money - and if you ordered because of my original review- please except my apology!

This product didn't come out as expected. I saw the same product of this at Barnes and Noble that has a better design. The book that was delivered to me just can't hold the quarters in place. They would always pop out and fall. This won't hold my quarters in place. I have to put the whole thing in a ziplock bag just to make sure I don't lose anything. I got what Barnes and Noble has, and it solved the problem. Don't get this. It's a waste of money.

I thought this would be a kit, it was only the insert.

What a fun and educational project for kids: collect all 50 "statehood" quarters. I previously bought a folder for my daughter to collect these quarters, and it was pretty boring. When I saw this one -- with a booklet of info, map, more colorful layout -- I bought it and gave the first one away. Now I wish I didn't. The content in this folder is GREAT, lots for kids to learn. But it's nearly impossible to get the quarters in the holes, and even if you succeed they almost always fall out. This has been very frustrating for my 5-year-old. For this reason I would not recommend it.

The folder itself is nice with a booklet that gives information about all states but inserting the quarters just doesn't work. They don't just "press in" - they pop right out and you have to glue them in if you want them to stay in. We even tried hammering them in. I bought it for my grandson but there was no way he was getting the quarters to stay in.

I ordered this fully expecting it to be the FOLDER as it says. Instead all I got was the tiny book that comes INSIDE the folder, no outer cardboard folder with the plastic molded quarter holders. Now it's going to cost me more to order what I need and none of these descriptions seem to indicate what you really get.

I like the folder very much as I am collecting the statehood quarters for my grandchildren. The booklet inside gives them lots of information on our United States. The only drawback I have seen is sometimes the quarters pop out. Other than that, it is easier to use than the traditional folders for
coins.
