

Has pictures, descriptions, and areas in which individual plants are known to exist. I didn't realize there were oaks all around me, while only 3 foot high, they're everywhere!

It is important to note that this text is useful but it will not contain grasses, and other annual/flower. I combined this with a plants of Arizona and was able to identify over 120 species for ecology.
