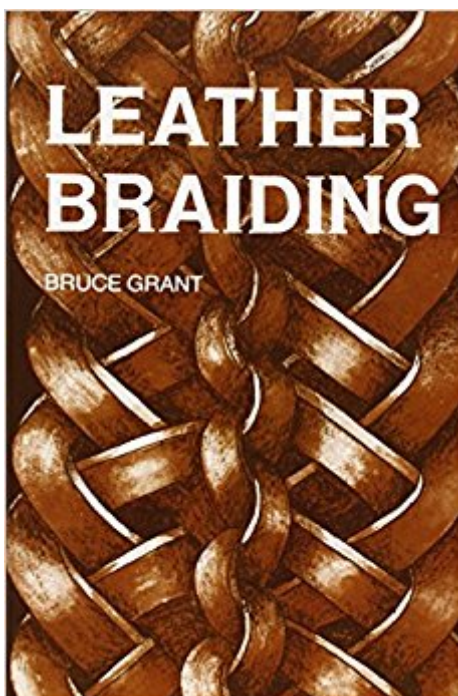


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# Tandy Leather Leather Braiding Book 6022-00
