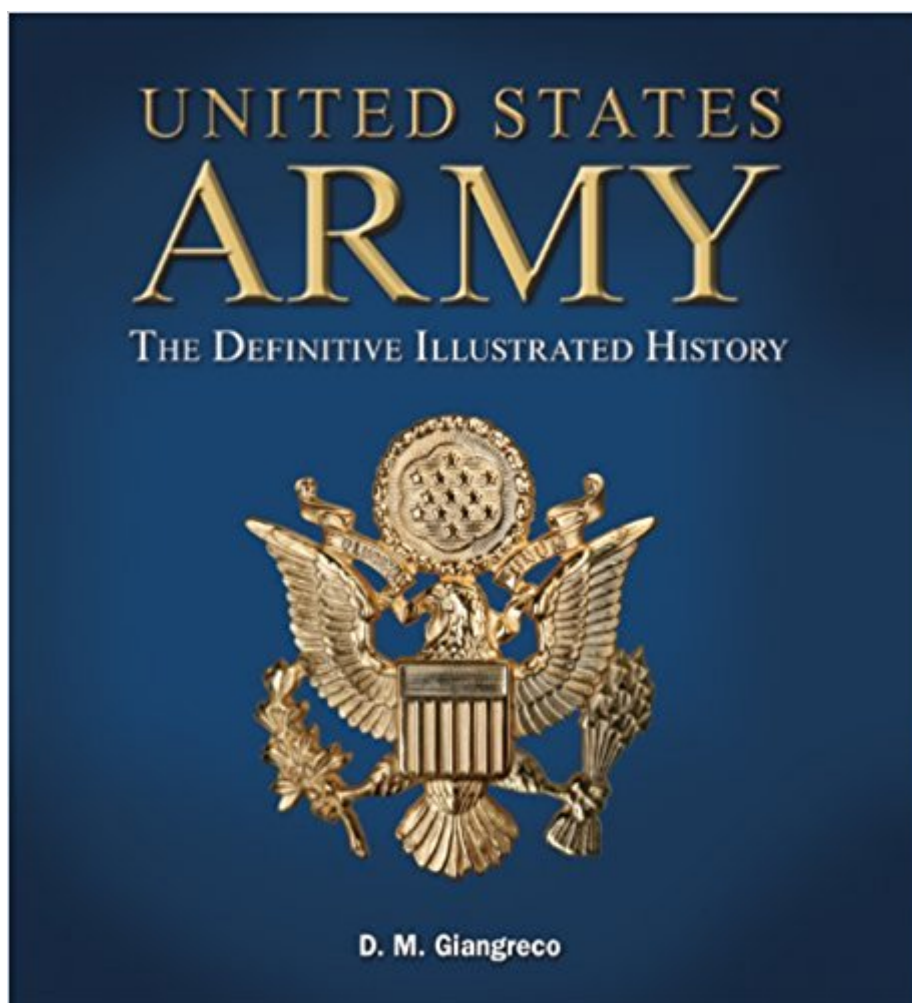

Award-winning author D.M. Giangreco is a former editor of the U.S. Army's professional journal, *Military Review*, and the author of numerous books about military affairs, including *War in Korea, 1950-1953*; *Delta: America's Elite Counterterrorist Force* (with Terry A. Griswold); *Eyewitness D-Day: Firsthand Accounts from the Landing at Normandy to the Liberation of Paris* (with Kathryn Moore); and *Eyewitness Pacific Theater: Firsthand Accounts of the War in the Pacific from Pearl Harbor to the Atomic Bomb* (with John T. Kuehn). He was also coauthor of *Eyewitness Vietnam: Firsthand Accounts from Operation Rolling Thunder to the Fall of Saigon* (with Donald L. Gilmore). Most recently, Giangreco was awarded the Moncado Prize by the Society for Military History for his article "Casualty Projects for the U.S. Invasions of Japan, 1945-1946: Planning and Policy Implications." His "Special Forces: The History Behind America's New Front-line Fighters" was the cover story of the November 2002 issue of *American Heritage*.
