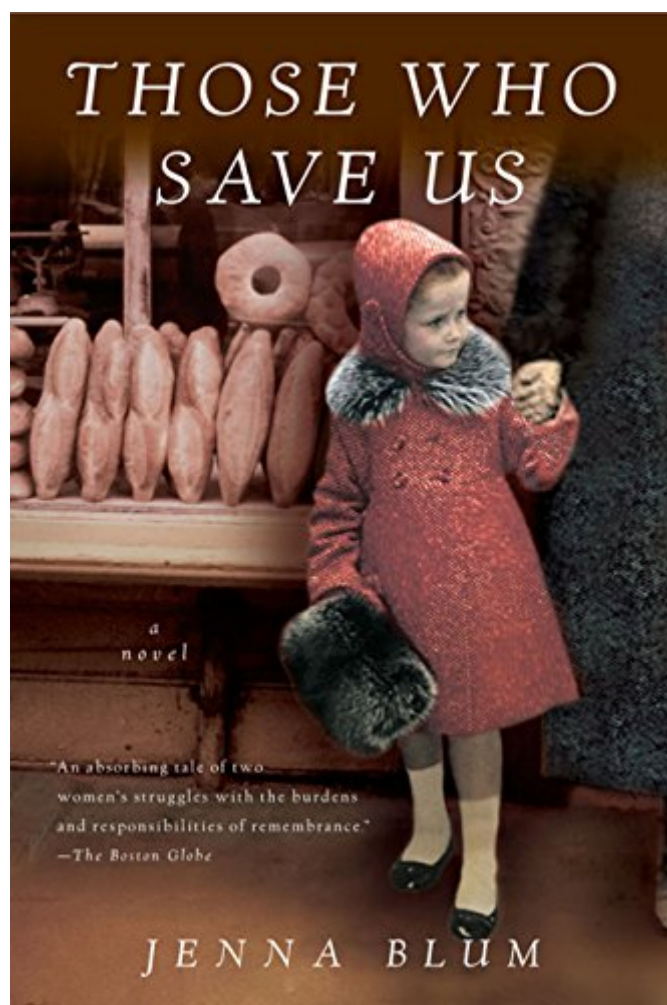


The book was found

Synopsis

For fifty years, Anna Schlemmer has refused to talk about her life in Germany during World War II. Her daughter, Trudy, was only three when she and her mother were liberated by an American soldier and went to live with him in Minnesota. Trudy's sole evidence of the past is an old photograph: a family portrait showing Anna, Trudy, and a Nazi officer, the Obersturmführer of Buchenwald. Driven by the guilt of her heritage, Trudy, now a professor of German history, begins investigating the past and finally unearths the dramatic and heartbreaking truth of her mother's life. Combining a passionate, doomed love story, a vivid evocation of life during the war, and a poignant mother/daughter drama, *Those Who Save Us* is a profound exploration of what we endure to survive and the legacy of shame.

There is no black and white, as some simplify it to, in WWII. There was rampant evil, there were acts of amazing grace, there were horrors that took many of my family members before I had the breath of a possibility of being their grand niece or grand daughter. But the beautiful layers of gray painted in this novel are worth the read. Especially the story of women stuck with impossible choices and still finding some way to try to do good, and survive.

Those Who Save Us did not captured attention immediately. However, as the story developed I was drawn into the desperate situation for Anna and her child. The movement between the past and presentation of three different view points as the story developed held my attention! The conclusion had me riveted to the end of the book and was overwhelmingly emotional! I would highly recommend this story for another perspective on the ghan experience!

Well written story dealing with the difficult topic of a woman who did things she would never normally have done in order to protect herself and her daughter during the supremely abnormal Nazi years in Germany.
