

Very weak on the content side, for a paperback. I did not want the Kindle version for travel convenience, and frankly it would be overpriced if you paid the digital cost. Content is simplistic, and seems like something that was developed for a blog. While there are ideas that seem interesting, too much of the 74 pages is spent on hyping side trips that seem to be hustling for a few tour operators. Even the interesting suggestions are not unique and can be retrieved with a hour or two of web surfing. While 74 pages isn't a lot to start with, the font size is quite large and the layout leaves too much white space. Overall the content could fit in 40 pages with some crisp editing. One major oversight is the lack of even simple, maps. There is no concept of distance, and this was most

noticeable in the Sicily section (its not a small island). Overall I'd suggest readers pass on the book. Spending twice as much on other tour books will get you twenty times times the content.

I could have written this book myself and I haven't been to Malta!
