

This is a well written book that not only tells the story of how difficult it is to purchase a constitutionally protected firearm in the District of Columbia but also details steps the current administration has taken to try to take away those rights across the country.

Emily Miller has many facts from her own experience and research that I've not read before, and all the facts are well documented in the appendix.
