

Interesting beginner story

Level 1 reader is stretching it. Uses contractions (they're, it's) which is not typically level 1. Very simple sentense and the text is not always related to the illustration. I would not purchase this again as I really wanted a book my granddaughter could read on her own. This one was not it.

My son loves soccer so I thought he would love this book. I think it would have been better for him at the beginning of the school year because it's a great level one book for early readers. The pictures are very nice. By the time I ordered it he claimed he found it too easy even though he's still in the level one reading group. He needed help with maybe two or three words total in the book. The first page is "We start the game." Then when you flip the page it has "We're ready" on the left and "We aim" on the right. It doesn't really get any harder than that. I hope his little brothers will enjoy reading it.

This is definitely a Level 1 book. If your toddler is learning to read, this book is good as a starter.

This book has too few words. The few words it has are not easily understandable even for an adult. Does not capture my child's attention much.
