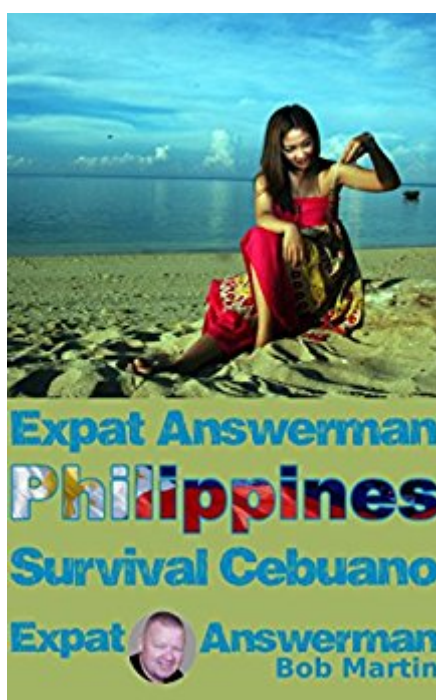

Bob Martin opens the way to begin understanding Cebuano in this very helpful introduction to the language widely spoken in the southern Philippines. Bob is an expert who lives in the Philippines. He explains many aspects of life in the Philippines. One confusion that Bob helped me understand is which language to study when visiting different parts of the Philippines. Before my 2014 trip to visit the Philippines, I spend six months studying Tagalog thinking it would be helpful. When visiting southern Philippines, Cebuano is required. Tagalog is mainly useful near Manila. During my trip, I met with Bob and found him friendly and helpful. I recommend this book and other books that Bob has available. You're looking for answers in the Philippines, read Bob's books.
