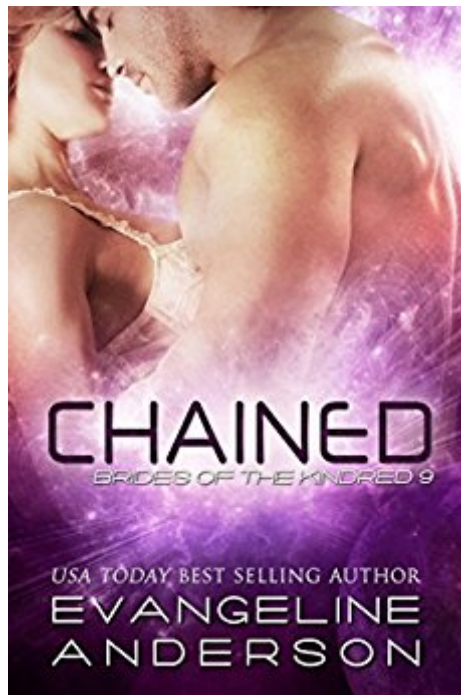

Evangleine Anderson is without question a very talented writer. I have read many of her books, not just those in the Brides of Kindred series. However, this is the first time I felt compelled to write a review. Maybe because I was so disappointed with the heroine. After reading the synopsis, I was prepared for a story that progressed a lot differently than what actually took place. My biggest gripe is the heroine is basically useless after she rescues the hero. The internal angst drove me nuts. By the time I finished 60% of the book I was saying out loud "I hate her!" I mean really, after justifying her actions to herself 50 or more times and having the hero buy into that foolishness I was just over it.

Maggie Jordon meets Kor when she saves him then Kor repays the favour and saves Maggie in this ninth erotic sci-fi novel in the series. Obviously they fall for each other, but gee whiz Maggie's character did my head in big time! If I hear her fiancé's name, Donald, one more time, I'll scream!
