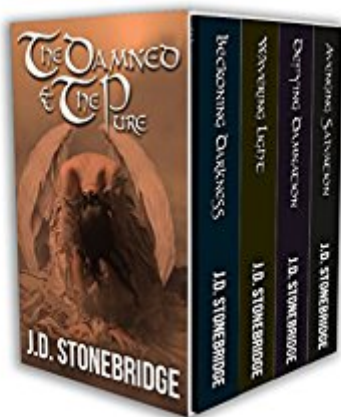

I was given a copy of this set of books by the author in exchange for an honest review. Beckoning Darkness is book one in a series of four books of The Damned and the Pure. The story will enrapture you. The characters become a part of your world as you enter theirs. The author did a very good job storytelling, enough so that this book played out more like a movie inside my mind than just words printed on paper. On the surface you may think, oh hey, a book about angels and demons, how original. Actually, it is very original. The blend of the pure and the damned is wonderfully set out in this attention capturer. Wavering light is book two. The suspense rises and you stay glued to this story until the last page, hungry for book three. Forget what you've been told is bad and good. Once you really get into this story, things are different and it is exciting to read and learn! Defying Damnation is book three. This is where the author is truly tested. The story heats up even more than before. You stay invested in these characters who have turned into people (or angels or demons etc.). Through the author's skilled storytelling, your world falls away as you hold your breath as the suspense rises. Avenging Salvation is the final book in this series. Lucifer, the archangels, mortals and the whole crew set the scene for your last, thrilling ride in this world of chaos and as the title says, salvation. I received a copy of this as an ARC from the author. I voluntarily decided to leave a review. This is my honest review. This book is one of the best fantasy books I've ever read, it's so intense and there is so much detail you can really imagine it happening which is a scary thought. It follows an angel Ariel who is thought of as naive but you soon realise she is anything but, then Caelum appears and at first I totally hated him but he grew on me! It's a twist of hell and heaven as we know it but so

many levels appear that you never hear about and its these levels which make you think it could happen. When I talked to my husband about the book he was so interested in the book which shocked me because normally he doesn't have any interest in the books I read, as my genre goes from romance through to fantasy and everything in between! But he's set on getting the copy for himself to read now. I read all of the books one after the other without much of a break because I couldn't put them down, I read until the early hours of the morning and woke to carry on, they were my obsession in the end, they are something I will read in the future again too. It's such a complex book and it goes through stages each book being a different set of events, it's very well written and the author has such an eye for detail making everything you've had in your mind's eye about heaven and hell do a 180. The first starts out as you'd imagine hell and heaven to be, Ariel gets sent to watch over someone to make sure no harm comes to him, then Caelum from hell appears and then it starts.... I felt as if I was there watching from the edge of it all because you get so much detail and information you can imagine it all happening in all of its glory. After the first few pages I was hooked but after the first book I had to know more because my mind was now on overdrive trying hard to grasp what's happened so far and what can possibly happen in the next book. I wasn't disappointed at all by the second book Ariel was still the main character with Caelum and he is slowly finding out that he might have a link to her could that be possible? You see him really struggle with things and this is where I really fall for him and feel sorry for him. This second book blew me away with the detail that went into it, none of the books are short at all they are as long as a normal book if not longer and I'm in awe that anyone could write such detail in four books of such length. You question everything in the end because by now nothing you've thought was true appears this way anymore, it's very surreal. The battles between the demons and the angels are so well written you can really imagine them playing out the way they do again you feel you are amongst it all when it kicks off. It amazed me the thought that must have gone into the whole series as each has such brilliant well written scenes and they are so well put together they must have taken forever to think up, you can see that the authors all has been put into this book because it's so much more than a book it's an amazing piece of work. I won't go into detail about book three or four because that wouldn't be fair but it threw me a loop for sure.
