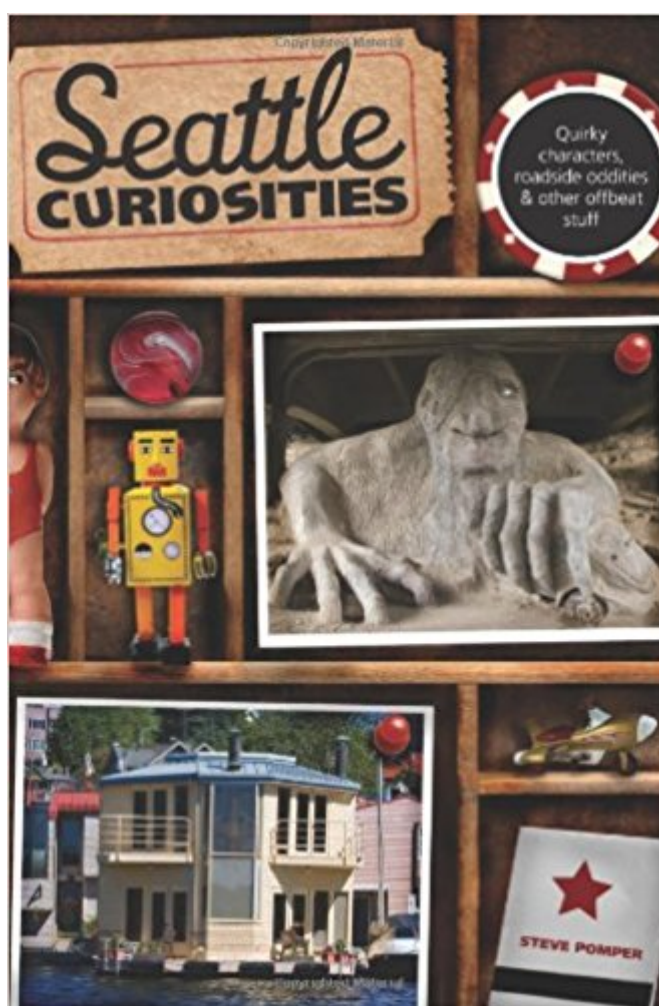

I highly recommend this book. I gave it to my sister to read and get some ideas (and a little local history lesson) of what she'd like to see and do before coming to see me and she's currently

enjoying it very much. If you're looking for a dry facts-only tour guide book, then this is not the book for you. This is not your typical dry informative tourist guide. This book is done with humor along the lines of Bill Speidel's Seattle Underground Tour (which I highly recommend taking!). If however you like a little typical Seattle Humor along with your facts, then I highly recommend picking up this book. theliterarygirl said: "...if I have no idea where downtown Seattle is located, or where the famous Pike Place Market is, it is very difficult to find that information without a time-consuming search through every section until I happen across it." theliterarygirl this COULD be a problem except that like most, if not all, tourist guide books, there is an index in the back of the book for all the local tourist sights in alphabetical order, along with their page numbers, which should greatly simplify looking things up for you and anyone else unfamiliar with Seattle. Lastly, I prefer a hard copy vs a Kindle for this kind of book. With any tour guide it's nice to be able to dog-ear a page, write notes in the margins, circle or mark a place or page in the index, etc.; so for that reason alone I would recommend picking up a hard copy vs the Kindle version.
