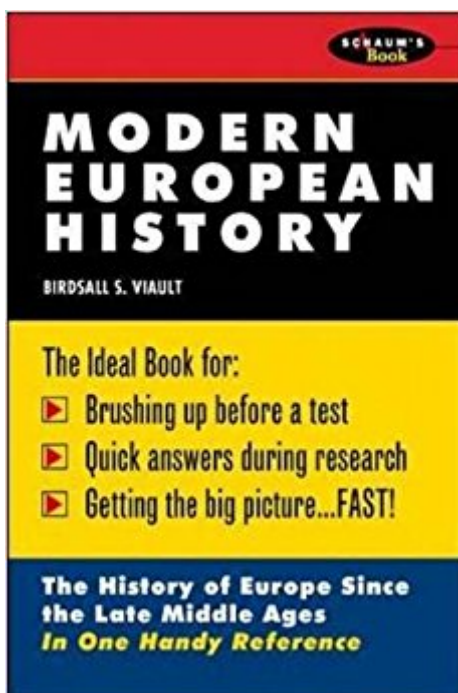

Modern European History is a very well written outline to European History. It is not overwhelmingly concerned with small details, rather it shows the big picture in European History. This is helpful for the AP Exam, for other classes, and for any debate. It doesn't have much detail but has many smaller things (The War of Jenkin's Ear, The Moroccan Crises, etc.) that aren't in the other AP books. This is helpful for citing examples, especially in the free response areas. Its outline format makes it easy to remember, and also helpful for the big picture in cultural, political, and economic changes over the centuries. I would definitely recommend this book to anyone studying for the AP exam, along with the Princeton Review guide to European History.

This book is so perfect for AP European History. I would use this as my clutch study guide for a few tests, and I never got below an A+. It is more detailed than many other guides, but all the information that it contains is very important. It is organized in a clear, concise way, and doesn't try to give you "strategies for a 5" or whatever, which don't really help anyway.

I read this book alongside the textbook and AP Prep Guide and found it very helpful. The format was great and gave good insights of both the general information as well as details. Definitely recommend!
