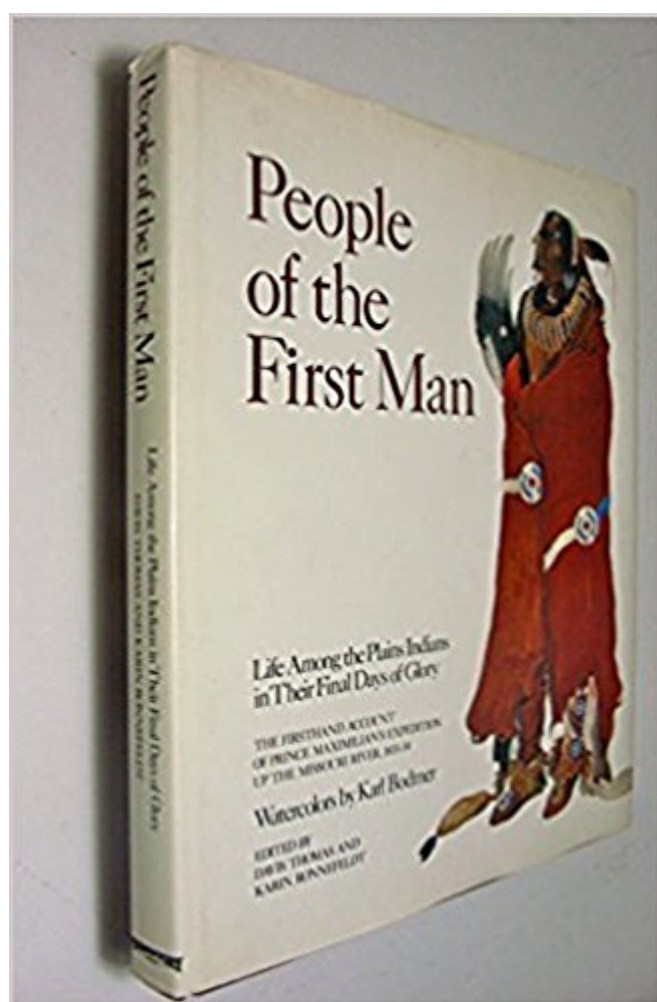

These proud peoples were very different from one another and had cultures that are well-worth studying. This fact alone would be enough for us to read the book. Modern day man has painted the American Indian with a broad brush that ignores a wonderfully developed Indian culture that should be studied and appreciated. It will be astonishing to realize how different they were from us and how much we are so much alike. The esteem of this edition is that it includes almost all the original watercolors realized by Bodmer during the expedition, and extracts from the original Maximilian journal that were not published in the original edition. On the other hand the heavy editorial crops makes "People of the First Man" not enough for the serious scholar.
