

Phillip Keller did just as good a job on them as he did on the first one. I would highly recommend this book to anyone who wants a better view of what the Good Shepherd is like.

These have always been my favorite scriptures since I was a little girl. This book has brought them alive to me once more in a more exciting way by showing me how deeply God cares for me. I have relaxed so much more and am enjoying every moment of every day in a fresh new way. Saying He leads and guides me is different than knowing He is leading me. My Worship, prayer and thankfulness have become deeper and I my relationship with Him is much clearer and deeper than ever before.

I have only read the first part and am using it with a Bible study group. The ladies agree, it touches the heart. My own experience with sheep also helps me understand even more what he is saying. One woman said, "Sheep aren't totally stupid. They recognize the voice of their master!"While I'm focusing on just the first part right now, I am eager to see what else Keller has to say.

This book has really helped me out. I came from an abusive church situation and needed a renewed view at my faith and this book did it for me. I became a christian because I wanted Christ to guide my life through all it's uncertainty (which He had), but that love was manipulated to control me by creating a Christ that did not love me, but was just using me. I needed to be able to be able to say that I wanted Him to have control of my life again. This book nailed it. I can understand and love Him as a good shepherd, and allow Him to have control of my life since it is for my good. This book teaches we are self destructive as humans and without the guidance and help from or shepherd we end up in trouble that He never intended for us. This book also brought back a piece to my life with

Christ.

This book gives you insight on the 23rd Psalm as it relates to sheep, and how a sheep's behavior can relate to our behavior. Also, how the shepherd's role is very much like that of Jesus' to us. It was written by a man who was a shepherd, so he knows the behavior of sheep, how they can get themselves in trouble, and how very much they need the shepherd. This is a very good book to keep on hand to remind oneself how much we need the real Shepherd.

I was particularly impressed by the first of the trilogy which dealt with the 23rd Psalm from the viewpoint of a shepherd. It was very helpful and gave me a whole new perspective to the 23rd Psalm that I hadn't know or perceived before. The other two books were also good but were more like sermons than informational/insightful. Excellent overall trilogy and would recommend it to those seeking a deeper relationship and understanding of God.
