Reading these stories was like returning to the valley where I grew up and being met with a warm welcome. We might be tempted to think those were simpler times, but farm life was, and still is, a series of challenges. In TALES OF THE PEANUT BUTTER KID, we learn how Larry Miller met those challenges with creativity, determination and a good dose of humor. Take a minute to read "Meanest Bull in the West," and you'll see exactly what I mean. I remember that day, actually. I'm the kid sister. These stories are real. I know you'll enjoy them as much as I did. The stories of our childhood live within each of us. Sometimes they stay hidden like the "stuff" a little boy collects in his pockets and then transfers to a small box, to be put away and never recalled. But these stories are the "best stuff." I loved this book!

I have to say, while reading this book I didn't analyze it, I just enjoyed it - a lot. This book has a couple of themes I'd like to point out, though. First, growing up in a rural setting comes with problems and possibilities different from those a boy finds in the city. It was good to get a glimpse of The Peanut Butter Kid's boyhood years and compare them to mine, growing up in a large city. Second, one of the biggest influences on a boy is the nature of his heroes. The author of THE TALES OF THE PEANUT BUTTER KID is fortunate to have had, as his primary hero, a man like his father. I can say the same about my early years and the qualities I saw in my own father. Personally, I think this book says as much about being a good father as it does about having one. My wife tells me it's hard to find a good gift for a man. This book is a _great_ gift.

What a wonderful set of stories! My wife gave me this book for Christmas and I'm happy to tell her that as she promised, it's an uplifting reminder of the grit and values that made this country great. Growing up on a Colorado farm always sounded full of adventure to me, and these stories confirm that. As hinted on the title page, I hope there's a Volume 2 in the works; these stories are extraordinary!

Having known Larry, and there family it was great to be reunited again through his words. This book of stories should be required reading for all school age kids. It would give them a great insight into real life and the struggles of a selfless family trying to survive. Thanks Larry !
